Free membership. First two years are free of charge.

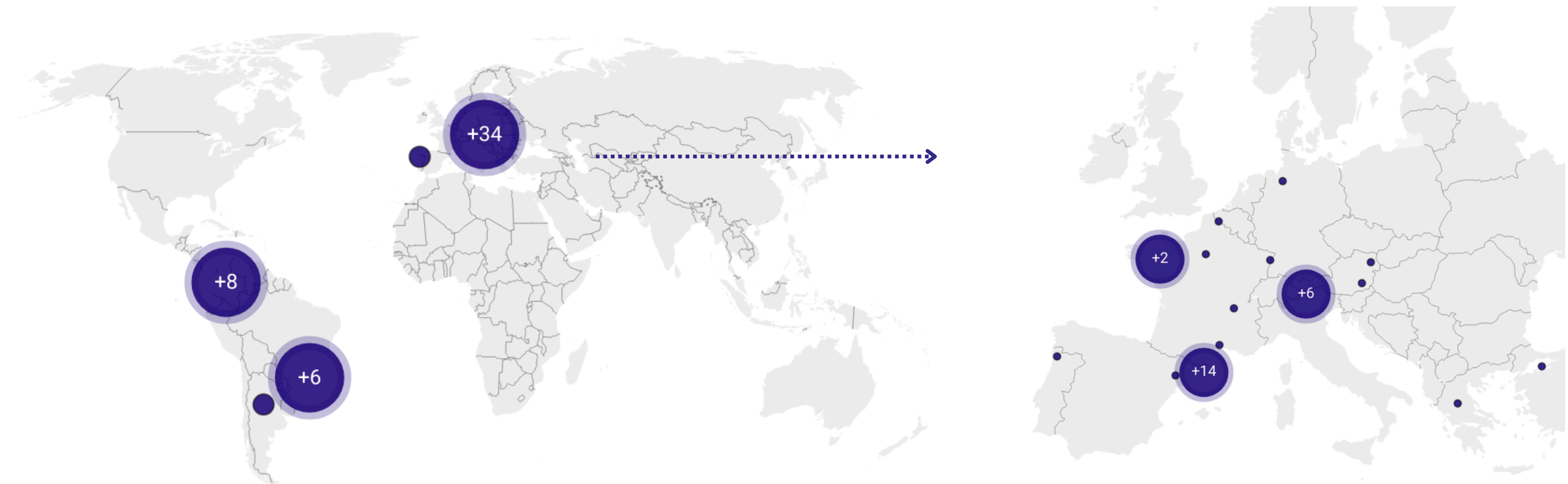


Support and financing. With EU funds and current financing from several Catalan institutions (Catalan Government, Barcelona City Council, Barcelona Provincial Council, and Barcelona Metropolitan Area).



Who are the Network members?

Currently, the Network has more than 50 member institutions, including cities, metropolises and regions from all over the world, such as Sant Boi, Barcelona, Milan, Strasbourg, Bogotá, Buenos Aires, Istanbul and Catalonia. **This represents a total of 90 million inhabitants worldwide.**



What does the Network do?

1. **INNOVATE:** Opportunities to build a community to understand and imagine what the right to time looks like in practice.
2. **IMPLEMENT:** Training and resources to learn how to implement time policies into different realities and contexts.
3. **NETWORK:** Organisation of exchange and awareness events (Annual assembly), and participation in key forums for public policy development.
4. **INSPIRE:** Award World Capital of Time, to create citizen awareness, foster the network sustainability and promote and consolidate innovative time policies.
